AN ACT REQUIRING DATE OF PACKAGING BY SELLERS OF
COLD CUT MEATS SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 94 is hereby amended by inserting after sec-
2 tion 150A the following section:—

3 *Section 150B.* Whoever knowingly exposes for sale or
4 has in his possession with intent to sell, for food, pack-
5 aged cold cut meats without a marking showing day,
6 month and year of packaging of said cold cut meats in
7 packages shall be punished by a fine of not more than
8 fifty dollars.
