By Mr. Rawson of Newton, petition of Frank C. Lydon for legislation to amend the law relative to cinematographs or motion picture machines operated with cellulose acetate films. Public Safety.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN AMENDMENT OF THE LAW RELATING TO THE CINEMATOGRAPH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 143 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 83, as appearing in the Tercen-
3 tenary Edition, and inserting in place thereof the follow-
4 ing new section:—

5 *Section 83.* Sections seventy-two to eighty-two,
6 inclusive, shall not apply to any motion picture machine
7 operated with cellulose acetate films or other slow-
8 burning films.
