By Mr. Stone of Clinton, petition of Victor Szaik and others for prohibiting the holding of more than one municipal office in the town of Lunenburg. Towns.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LUNENBURG TO PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM HOLDING MORE THAN ONE OF CERTAIN TOWN OFFICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Lunenburg may, by a vote
2 of a majority of those voting at the annual town meet-
3 ing, provide that no person shall hold more than one of
4 any of the following offices:—selectman, assessor, con-
5 stable, school committee, auditor, tree warden, library
6 trustee, park commissioner, planning board or trust fund
7 commissioner. The provisions of this act shall not be
8 construed as preventing the board of selectmen from
9 serving as the board of health or board of public welfare.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall not affect the present term
2 of any incumbent of more than one of the said offices
3 on the effective date of this act.
