AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT TO ALLAN A. GILLIS FOR MATERIALS, ALTERATIONS AND EXTRA WORK FURNISHED AND PERFORMED AT THE STATE INFIRMARY AT TEWKSBURY, MASSACHUSETTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 For the purpose of discharging a moral obligation of
2 the commonwealth, and after an appropriation has been
3 made, there shall be paid from the state treasury to
4 Allan A. Gillis, as assignee of Allan A. Gillis Construc-
5 tion Company, the sum of seventy-five thousand two
6 hundred and seventy-three dollars and twenty-seven
7 cents, with interest thereon, for materials, alterations
8 and extra work furnished and performed by said Allan A.
9 Gillis Construction Company in connection with the
10 construction of three buildings at the state infirmary at
11 Tewksbury, Massachusetts, under a contract entered
12 into with the commonwealth dated December first,
13 nineteen hundred and thirty-one.
