AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS TO REBUILD THAT PART OF ROUTE 7 LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSTOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
2 and directed to rebuild that part of Route 7 located in
3 the town of Williamstown from the intersection of
4 North and Main streets north for a distance of one
5 hundred and fifty feet, or more, beyond the intersection
6 of Whitman and North streets in said town. For such
7 purpose said department may expend such sums as may
8 hereafter be appropriated therefor.

The Committee on the subject of the proposed amendments to the Constitution of the United States, have the honor to report to the House of Representatives, that they have considered the same, and have the honor to recommend that they be passed.

The Constitution of the United States

Article I, Section 1, Clause 1

All legislative Powers herein granted shall be vested in a Congress of the United States, which shall consist of a Senate and House of Representatives.

Section 1. The House of Representatives shall be composed of Members chosen every second Year by the People of the several States, and the Electors in each State shall have the Qualifications requisite for Electors in that State.
