AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALARY OF THE PRESENT CLERK OF THE SECOND DISTRICT COURT OF BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
2 seventy-nine of chapter two hundred and eighteen of the
3 General Laws, the salary of the present incumbent of the
4 office of clerk of the second district court of Barnstable
5 shall be thirty-eight hundred dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
