AN ACT PROVIDING FOR INCREASING BAIL FEES IN CERTAIN
CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 24 of chapter 262 of the General Laws, as
2 amended, is hereby further amended by striking out the
3 period at the end thereof and inserting the following:—
4 , except that when an arrest is made and bail taken
5 between the hours of twelve midnight and six o'clock in
6 the morning the maximum fee shall be five dollars.
