## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT EXTENDING MEMBERSHIP IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEMS OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO PERSONS WHO ENTERED SERVICE BETWEEN THE AGES OF SIXTY TO SIXTY-EIGHT IN GROUP A AND AGES SIXTY TO SIXTY-THREE IN GROUP B.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 32 of the General Laws, section 3, sub-  
2 division (2) (iv) is hereby amended by striking out the  
3 word "sixty" in the first sentence and inserting in place  
4 thereof the words:— sixty-eight in Group A and age  
5 sixty-three in Group B.
