AN ACT PERMITTING THE MANUFACTURE OF FRANKFURTERS
CONTAINING COLORING MATTER AND REGULATING THE
SALE THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Section 143 of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 318 of the acts of
3 1930, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of
4 said section the following sentence:— Nothing in this
5 section shall prohibit the manufacture of frankfurters
6 containing coloring matter; provided that the same
7 are not sold within the commonwealth.
