The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES TO ACQUIRE CERTAIN LAND ALONG THE TACONIC TRAIL.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of natural resources is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to acquire by purchase certain
3 land along the Taconic Trail, to wit:— the land and
4 buildings now owned by Sanborn J. Tenney or his heirs
5 located on the north and south sides of said Taconic
6 Trail. The department is authorized to expend for
7 such purpose such sums of money as may hereafter be
8 appropriated therefor.
