### AN ACT TO PREVENT THE REVOCATION OF CERTAIN DRIVING LICENSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The registrar of motor vehicles is hereby  
2 authorized and directed to provide for the re-issue of a  
3 new license to drivers of commercial motor vehicles en-  
4 gaged in the transportation of passengers for hire, whose  
5 original license has been revoked or suspended because  
6 of a fatality caused by said drivers' judicially determined  
7 negligence while operating a privately owned car.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply only to that class of  
2 persons ordinarily and regularly engaged in earning their  
3 livelihood by employment as operators of commercial  
4 vehicles for public or private hire.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
