AN ACT EXTENDING VETERANS' BENEFITS TO THE WIDOWS OF CERTAIN VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Whenever any special or general law grants benefits,
2 rights, preferences or privileges to disabled veterans,
3 the same shall be granted, wherever applicable, to un-
4 remarried widows of veterans who died while on active
5 service in the armed forces, notwithstanding any pro-
6 vision of law to the contrary.
