## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT REQUIRING ALL PERSONS ENGAGED IN HANDLING FOOD TO HAVE A MEDICAL CERTIFICATE AND TO UNDERGO A MEDICAL EXAMINATION EVERY SIX MONTHS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 305A of chapter 94 of the General Laws, as  
2 inserted by section 1 of chapter 229 of the acts of 1928,  
3 is hereby amended by inserting before the first sentence  
4 thereof the following sentence: — All persons engaged  
5 in handling food must have a medical certificate and  
6 undergo a medical examination every six months by a  
7 physician duly licensed and registered to practice in the  
8 commonwealth.
