AN ACT REQUIRING THAT A BRANCH OFFICE OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD BE ESTABLISHED IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 There shall be established in the city of Worcester
2 a branch office of the appellate tax board, consisting of
3 an assistant clerk from the present staff and a typist-
4 stenographer to assist taxpayers of Worcester county
5 and the surrounding communities in the preparation of
6 tax appeal matters.
