AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AIDING OF BLIND PERSONS BY THE DIVISION OF THE BLIND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 23 of chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "care", in line 5,
3 as appearing in chapter 458 of the acts of 1947, the words:
4 — and hospitalization, — so that the first paragraph will
5 read as follows: — The director may ameliorate the con-
6 dition of the blind by devising means to facilitate the
7 circulation of books, by promoting visits among the
8 aged or helpless blind in their homes, by aiding individual
9 blind persons with money or other assistance, including
10 the furnishing of medical care or hospitalization, or by
11 any other method he may deem expedient; provided,
12 that contributions by the division for aid to any blind
13 person shall be based on the needs of the recipient, with
14 a minimum of forty dollars per month, less whatever re-
15 sources he may have. In furnishing aid to each claimant
16 for aid to the blind, the director shall disregard earned in-
17 come up to fifty dollars per month of each such claimant.
