In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS OF THE UNITED STATES TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

1    *Resolved*, That in order that the commonwealth may  
2 be properly represented on the occasion of the national  
3 convention of the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the  
4 United States, to be held in the city of Boston in the  
5 current year, and to ensure, in arranging entertainments  
6 and other events in connection therewith, proper co-  
7 operation between the Massachusetts Department of  
8 the Veterans of Foreign Wars of the United States and the  
9 commonwealth, there may be expended, with the ap-  
10 proval and under the direction of the governor and coun-  
11 cil, such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
