RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A PROPER REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE FEDERAL EMPLOYEES VETERANS ASSOCIATION, INC., TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE CURRENT YEAR.

1 *Resolved*, That, in order that the commonwealth may
2 be properly represented on the occasion of the national
3 convention of the Federal Employees Veterans Asso-
4 ciation, Inc., to be held in the city of Boston on Septem-
5 ber thirtieth and October first and second of the current
6 year, and to ensure, in arranging entertainment and
7 other events in connection therewith, proper co-operation
8 between the Federal Employees Veterans Association,
9 Inc., and the commonwealth, there may be expended,
10 with the approval and under the direction of the governor
11 and council such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
