AN ACT PROVIDING FOR A FIFTY-SIX HOUR WEEK FOR PERMANENT MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT IN THE TOWN OF MILFORD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The hours of duty of the permanent  
2 members of the uniformed fire-fighting force in the town  
3 of Milford shall be so established by the chief of the fire  
4 department that the average weekly hours of duty in  
5 any year, other than hours during which such members  
6 may be summoned and kept on duty because of conflagra-  
7 tions, shall not exceed fifty-six in number.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted for acceptance  
2 of said town at its next annual town meeting in the form  
3 of the following question, which shall be placed on the  
4 official ballot to be used for the election of town officers  
5 at said meeting: — “Shall an act passed by the General  
6 Court in the current year, entitled ‘An act providing  
7 for a fifty-six hour week for permanent members of the  
8 Fire Department in the town of Milford’ be accepted?”  
9 If a majority of votes in answer to said question is in  
10 the affirmative, this act shall thereupon take full effect,  
11 but not otherwise.
