AN ACT MAKING THE PROVISIONS OF THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS APPLICABLE TO THE TOWN OF SWAMPSCOTT WITH RESPECT TO ITS WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter thirty-one of
2 the General Laws and the rules made thereunder,
3 including those relative to the employment of laborers
4 designated as the "labor service", shall be in force in
5 the town of Swampscott with respect to all appointive
6 offices and positions in the water and sewer depart-
7 ments of said town.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the
2 voters of said town at the annual town meeting in the
3 current year in the form of the following question,
4 which shall be placed upon the official ballot to be used
5 for the election of town officers at said meeting:—
6 "Shall an act passed by the General Court in the year
7 nineteen hundred and fifty-five, entitled 'An Act making
8 the provisions of the civil service laws applicable to the
9 town of Swampscott with respect to its water and
10 sewer departments', be accepted." If a majority of the
11 votes in answer to said question are in the affirmative,
12 then this act shall thereupon take effect, but not
13 otherwise.
