AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LUDLOW TO USE CERTAIN PARK LAND FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Ludlow is hereby authorized
2 to use such portion of Veteran's park, located in said
3 town and situate on Chapin street, as the town, by vote
4 passed at any annual or special town meeting within
5 five years after the passage of this act, shall determine,
6 for the erection of a public school building or for other
7 school uses, and for all purposes incidental thereto; and
8 after such vote, such portion shall be under the same care
9 and control as other school property.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
