Ordered, That the committee on Civil Service of the present General Court be authorized to continue the investigation authorized (under the provisions of an order jointly adopted on June 10, 1954) relative to the extension of civil service to additional state employees, the establishment of a clerical pool in the Department of Civil Service and Registration and the giving of civil service preference to servicemen and their widows and to certain handicapped persons. Said committee may expend the balance of any appropriation heretofore made for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this order. Said committee shall file its report and its recommendations, if any, with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or before March second in the current year.
