AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF FITCHBURG TO APPROPRIATE A SUM OF MONEY FOR THE ACQUISITION OF LAND AND BUILDINGS THEREON AND TO DEFRAY THE COST THEREOF BY BORROWING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 608 of the acts of 1954 is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 3 the following
3 section:—

4 *Section 3A.* Fees or receipts from parking meters
5 installed and maintained by said city under authority
6 of sections twenty-two A, twenty-two B or section
7 twenty-two C of chapter forty of the General Laws
8 may be used by it to pay the principal and interest, or
9 principal or interest, of bonds issued by it under authority
10 of section three of this act.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by the city council of said city, subject to
3 the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
