### AN ACT PROVIDING COMPENSATORY VACATION TIME FOR CERTAIN STATE EMPLOYEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 24A of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 400 of the acts of  
3 1953, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
4 word "allowed;" the following:— and provided, that  
5 when an employee who regularly works five or more  
6 days a week is on vacation, and any of the above-  
7 mentioned holidays falls on one of his regularly scheduled  
8 working days, he shall be granted an additional day of  
9 vacation;
