AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ISSUING OF LICENSES TO OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES FOR THE CARRIAGE OF PASSENGERS FOR HIRE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 9 of chapter 159A of the General Laws, as ap-
2 pearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is hereby amended
3 by adding at the end the following sentence:— Such
4 license shall be renewed yearly and shall be invalid until
5 endorsed with the name of the motor carrier employing
6 the person to whom the license is issued, and such em-
7 ployer shall notify the department upon termination of
8 such employment whereupon such license shall terminate.
