AN ACT RELATIVE TO SEWER BETTERMENT ASSESSMENTS IN THE TOWN OF NORTH ANDOVER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 380 of the acts of 1906 is hereby
2 amended by inserting after section 8 the following two
3 sections:—

4 *Section 8A.* The said board may extend the time
5 for the payment of such assessments upon land which
6 is not built upon until it is built upon or for a fixed time
7 —by interest at the rate of four per cent per annum
8 paid annually to the treasurer upon the assessment from
9 the time it was made, and the assessment shall be paid
10 before the land is built upon or at the expiration of such
11 fixed time.

12 *Section 8B.* Assessments made under this chapter
13 shall bear interest at the rate of four per cent per annum
14 instead of six per cent per annum.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of a majority of the voters of the
3 town of North Andover at any town meeting called for
4 the purpose, but not otherwise.
