AN ACT RELATIVE TO SICK LEAVE FOR CERTAIN POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4 of chapter 146 of the acts of
2 1947 is hereby amended by striking out the second sen-
3 tence and inserting in place thereof the following sen-
4 tence: — Sick leave not used in the year in which it ac-
5 crues may be accumulated for use in a subsequent year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of the city of Bos-
3 ton, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not
4 otherwise.
