Sullivan and the Disabled American Veterans, Department of Massachusetts, that provision be made for compilation of veterans' laws in one volume; the petition (accompanied by resolve, House, No. 1415) of The American Legion, Department of Massachusetts, and others that provision be made for compiling and printing the laws relating to veterans and their organizations; and the petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 1662) of William X. Wall that provision be made for compilation in one volume of the laws pertaining to veterans, report the accompanying resolve (House, No. 2547).

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPILING AND PRINTING OF
THE LAWS OF THE COMMONWEALTH RELATIVE TO VET-
ERANS AND THEIR ORGANIZATIONS.

1 *Resolved*, That the committees on rules of the two
2 branches, acting concurrently, are hereby authorized to
3 have printed in pamphlet form in one edition of not more
4 than thirty thousand copies, the compiled, indexed and
5 annotated laws of the commonwealth, up to and includ-
6 ing the year nineteen hundred and fifty-five, relating to
7 veterans and to their organizations.
