AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT APPORTIONMENT COMMISSIONERS FOR SUFFOLK COUNTY SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF FOUR YEARS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 161 of chapter 54 of
2 the General Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary
3 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 7, the
4 word "two" and inserting in place thereof the word:
5 — four.
