Ordered, That the committee on state administration is hereby authorized to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of making an investigation and study of the subject matter of current house document numbered 1738, relative to requiring public service corporations to defray the cost of investigations and special services on an equitable basis. Said committee shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry said recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of representatives on or before the first Wednesday of December in the current year.
