AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK TO PAY A  
PENSION TO WILLIAM J. BRICKLEY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of promoting the public  
2 good, the county of Suffolk is hereby authorized to pay  
3 to William J. Brickley, medical examiner for Suffolk  
4 county, northern district, who served the city of Boston  
5 and the county of Suffolk faithfully and efficiently for  
6 thirty-five years, a pension equal to one half of his pres-  
7 ent salary, the same to be paid in equal monthly instal-  
8 ments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of the city of  
3 Boston, subject to the provisions of its charter, but not  
4 otherwise.
