By Mr. Randall of Framingham, petition of William I. Randall and Anthony M. Colonna that the town of Framingham be authorized to pay an annuity to John L. Regan, a former police officer in said town. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO A YEARLY PENSION TO JOHN L. REGAN TO BE PAID BY THE TOWN OF FRAMINGHAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Framingham is hereby au-
2 thorized to pay to John L. Regan, a patrolman in said
3 town of Framingham, a yearly pension equal to the high-
4 est rate of pay received by the said John L. Regan, while
5 in the employ of the town of Framingham as a police
6 officer, as an annuity, for life; the same to be paid in
7 equal monthly installments.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by vote of a town meeting of said town, subject to
3 the provisions of its charter.
