## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF PEABODY TO PENSION MARY L. PIERCE, WIDOW OF GEORGE A. PIERCE, A FORMER EMPLOYEE OF THE ELECTRIC LIGHT DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Peabody, for the purpose of  
2 promoting the public good, is hereby authorized to pay  
3 to Mary L. Pierce, widow of George A. Pierce, who died  
4 on May twenty-seventh, nineteen hundred and twenty-  
5 five, from electrocution while an employee of the elec-  
6 tric light department of the city, a pension for life of the  
7 sum of                      dollars per year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its  
2 acceptance by vote of the city council of said city, sub-  
3 ject to the provisions of its charter, but not otherwise.
