AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO PAY A SUM OF MONEY TO GEORGE FLAHERTY OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. For the purpose of discharging a moral
2 obligation, the city of Springfield may appropriate and
3 pay to George Flaherty of said city such sums of money,
4 not in excess of one thousand fourteen dollars and forty-
5 seven cents, as may be necessary to reimburse him for
6 hospital, medical and other expenses, not compensated
7 for by insurance, incurred by him on account of injuries
8 received by his minor daughter, Nancy Ann Flaherty,
9 on school property of said city.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
