AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ALLEVIATION OF CERTAIN FINANCIAL BURDENS IMPOSED BY THE HURRICANES OF AUGUST THIRTY-FIRST AND SEPTEMBER ELEVENTH, NINETEEN HUNDRED AND FIFTY-FOUR.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 689 of the acts of
2 1954, as amended by section 1 of chapter 46 of the acts
3 of the current year, is hereby further amended by in-
4 serting after the word "commissions" in the third line
5 of subparagraph (3) the words: — and, in addition, for
6 the fiscal year nineteen hundred and fifty-six of the di-
7 vision of waterways in the department of public works,
8 — so that said subparagraph will read as follows: —

9 (3) To reimburse the appropriation accounts avail-
10 able for the fiscal year nineteen hundred and fifty-five
11 of the several other state departments, boards and com-
12 missions, and, in addition, for the fiscal year nineteen
13 hundred and fifty-six of the division of waterways in the
14 department of public works, such amounts as, in the
15 opinion of the commission are necessary and have been
16 expended therefrom for purposes of disaster relief or
17 repair of hurricane damage, including the expense of the
18 services of national guard units duly called for service in
19 the stricken areas.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July first,
2 nineteen hundred and fifty-five.
