To accompany the petition of Charles V. Hogan that provision be made for the establishment of a minimum weekly rate for the care of disabled persons who are inmates or patients of boarding homes or other institutions and who are receiving public aid. Public Welfare.

AN ACT ESTABLISHING A MINIMUM WEEKLY RATE FOR THE CARE OF DISABLED PERSONS WHO ARE INMATES OR PATIENTS OF BOARDING HOMES, NURSING HOMES, REST HOMES OR OTHER INSTITUTIONS AND WHO ARE RECEIVING ASSISTANCE UNDER THE LAW PROVIDING FOR ASSISTANCE TO PERSONS WHO ARE DISABLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law to
2 the contrary, or rule or regulation made thereunder, the
3 minimum weekly rate for the care of any inmate or
4 patient of a boarding home, nursing home, rest home or
5 other institution caring for persons who are receiving
6 assistance under the provisions of chapter one hundred
7 and eighteen D of the General Laws shall be twenty-five
8 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
