To accompany the petition of Francis X. McCann for legislation to provide that certain State and municipal employees be compensated according to the nature of the work they perform. Public Service.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN STATE AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES BE COMPENSATED ACCORDING TO THE NATURE OF THE WORK THEY PERFORM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
2 trary, temporary services performed by a regular state,
3 city or town employee in a salary classification higher
4 than that on which such employee is regularly em-
5 ployed, shall be compensated for at the wage scale for
6 the classification which such employee temporarily oc-
7 cupies.
