AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE EXTENSION OF CIVIL SERVICE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE MASSACHUSETTS MARITIME ACADEMY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 4 of chapter 31 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following new
