To accompany the petition of Charles J. Innes for legislation relative to the securing of information concerning persons residing at inns, lodging houses and public lodging houses. Election Laws.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SECURING OF INFORMATION CONCERNING PERSONS RESIDING AT INNS, LODGING HOUSES AND PUBLIC LODGING HOUSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 51 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
2 striking out section 10A and inserting in place thereof the
3 following section: —
4 *Section 10A.* Every innholder licensed under any pro-
5 vision of chapter one hundred and forty and every keeper
6 of a lodging house or public lodging house licensed there-
7 under shall deliver to the person performing the duties
8 required by section four, on a suitable blank to be fur-
9 nished him by said person, a statement signed under
10 penalties of perjury showing the name of every person
11 twenty years of age or older on January first of said year
12 whose place of residence on said January first was at such
13 inn, lodging house or public lodging house.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF
 THE SENATE AND TO THE APPOINTMENT OF MEMBERS OF
 THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
 General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same
 as follows:

- 1 Chapter 21 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
 striking out section 10B and inserting in place thereof the
 following section:
- 2 Section 10A. Every individual whose name appears
 in the list of names and who has not been previously
 elected shall deliver to the clerk of the Senate or the
 clerk of the House, on or before the first day of
 the month of January, a statement of his or her
 qualifications as prescribed in this section, and if
 he or she is not a resident of this Commonwealth on
 the first day of January next he or she shall also
 file with the clerk of the Senate or the clerk of the
 House a statement of his or her qualifications as
 prescribed in this section.
