AN ACT DESIGNATING HUNTS FALLS BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF LOWELL AS REV. JOHN J. SHAW BRIDGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Hunt Falls bridge in the city of Lowell shall, upon its
2 completion by the state department of public works,
3 be known and designated as the Rev. John J. Shaw
4 bridge, in honor of a former pastor of Saint Michael's
5 church in the city of Lowell. Said department is hereby
6 authorized and directed to erect on said bridge a suit-
7 able tablet or marker bearing such designation, and may
8 expend therefor such sum as may be appropriated.
