## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW IN REGARD TO THE ELIGIBILITY FOR BENEFITS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws, as amended, is  
2 hereby amended by striking out subsection (a) and sub-  
3 stituting therefor the following:—

4 (a) Have been paid wages in his base period of not  
5 less than five hundred dollars, and have been paid wages  
6 in each of thirteen weeks in his base period in an amount  
7 at least equal to the benefits he would have received if  
8 totally unemployed.
