## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING PART TIME WORKERS TO OBTAIN CERTAIN BENEFITS UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT SECURITY LAW.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 151A of the General Laws is hereby amended  
2 by inserting after section 31 the following section:—  
3 *Section 31A.* An individual who, owing to personal  
4 circumstances, is unable or unwilling to work full time,  
5 and who normally works less than full time may register  
6 as a part-time worker in such manner as the director may  
7 prescribe. The director may fix the conditions required  
8 to qualify for benefits in such cases and may modify the  
9 provisions of section twenty-four. He shall also fix pro-  
10 portionate maximum and minimum benefits in place of  
11 the maximum and minimum amounts provided in sec-  
12 tions twenty-nine and thirty.
