AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE BY THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION OF A FIELD HOUSE AND ATHLETIC FIELD AT FOSS PARK IN THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby au-
2 thorized and directed to lay out, establish and maintain,
3 in Foss park in the city of Somerville, a recreation
4 area with adequate facilities for football and baseball
5 games, including the erection of permanent stands, and
6 said commission is further authorized and directed to
7 construct and thereafter to maintain at said Foss park,
8 on the site of the present pond area, a field house with
9 dressing rooms, lockers, showers and incidental facilities.
10 Said commission may expend for the purposes of this
11 act such sums as may be appropriated therefor.
