AN ACT PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE BUDGET OF THE SOLDIERS' HOME AND HOSPITAL IN THE CITY OF CHELSEA.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The budget of the Soldiers' Home and  
2 Hospital in Chelsea, Massachusetts, shall be not less  
3 than ten thousand dollars per year, in order to pro-  
4 vide the needed medication prescribed by the physicians  
5 in the out-patient department of the Soldiers' Home  
6 and Hospital to the veterans who must use the out-  
7 patient department for their non-service connected dis-  
8 abilities and are unable to purchase outside on account  
9 of low income. This provision of law shall remain a  
10 permanent law for the veterans in the out-patient de-  
11 partment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
