RESOLUTIONS COMMENDING THE MASSACHUSETTS DENTAL SOCIETY.

Resolved, That the Massachusetts Senate extends its congratulations to the Massachusetts Dental Society on the occasion of its nineteen hundred and fifty-five Educational Meeting, held in Boston, for its contribution in presenting to members of the dental profession by a closed circuit television program the proper technique of the administration of the newer anesthetic agents, utilizing all the necessary equipment and employing all known safety measures, and presenting three actual dental operations by qualified personnel using general anesthetic techniques; and be it further
