### RESOLUTIONS ON THE DEATH OF PAUL A. MCCARTHY.

*Whereas*, The Massachusetts Senate has learned with deep sorrow of the death of Paul A. McCarthy of Somerville, a former member of the general court of Massachusetts, who died on April third, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, after a lingering illness; and

*Whereas*, His honored and long career as a member of the house of representatives from nineteen hundred and thirty-seven to nineteen hundred and fifty-four distinguished him as an upright and conscientious legislator, an outstanding orator, fearless in the discharge of his duty, and courageous in the face of a long illness; therefore be it

*Resolved*, That the Massachusetts senate hereby extends to the family of the deceased its deep sympathy and condolence in their bereavement, and that there be transmitted by the state secretary to said family a copy of these resolutions.
