AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO THE WEYMOUTH AGRICULTURAL AND INDUSTRIAL SOCIETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING DOG RACING MEETINGS AT THE WEYMOUTH STATE FAIR.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause (o) of section 3 of chapter 128A  
2 of the General Laws, as amended by section 3 of chapter  
3 405 of the acts of 1936, is hereby further amended by  
4 adding at the end of the first paragraph thereof, the  
5 following: — ; provided, however, that the commission  
6 may issue licenses to the Weymouth Agricultural and  
7 Industrial Society, a Massachusetts corporation, for the  
8 purpose of conducting dog racing meetings at the Wey-  
9 mouth state fair.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

## The Commission of Finance

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Two.

AN ACT TO ORGANIZE THE COMMISSION OF FINANCE AND TAXATION, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXERCISE OF ITS FUNCTIONS.

THE COMMISSION OF FINANCE AND TAXATION, created by the Senate of 1871, and the Commission of Finance and Taxation, created by the Senate of 1872, be and they are hereby authorized to execute the duties devolving upon them.

1. The Commission of Finance and Taxation shall consist of five members, to be appointed by the Senate.
2. One of the members shall be designated as Chairman.
3. The members shall hold office for the term of two years.
4. The Commission shall report to the Senate at the end of its term.
5. The Commission shall also report to the Senate at the end of each year.
6. The Commission shall have the same powers as the Commission of Finance and Taxation, created by the Senate of 1871.
7. The Commission shall have the same powers as the Commission of Finance and Taxation, created by the Senate of 1872.
8. The Commission shall have the same powers as the Commission of Finance and Taxation, created by the Senate of 1873.

Approved: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
