AN ACT RELATIVE TO CREDITABLE PRIOR SERVICE OF CATHARINE E. O'CONNELL KENNEY IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF BROCKTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any provision of chapter thirty-two of  
2 the General Laws to the contrary notwithstanding, Cath-  
3 arine E. O'Connell Kenney, a member of the contribu-  
4 tory retirement system of the city of Brockton, shall,  
5 for the purpose of determining her retirement allowance  
6 under the contributory retirement system of said city,  
7 have credited to her, as creditable service, the period be-  
8 tween the years nineteen hundred and twenty and nine-  
9 teen hundred and thirty, inclusive, during which she  
10 was in the employ of said city, as part of her continuous  
11 service.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
