AN ACT TO FACILITATE THE SALE OF VETERANS' HOUSING
CONSTRUCTED ON LAND ACQUIRED THROUGH TAX TITLE
FORECLOSURE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is to expedite those
3 sales of residences constructed for veterans under sec-
4 tion six of chapter three hundred and seventy-two of the
5 acts of nineteen hundred and forty-six and acts amend-
6 tory thereof which are being impeded by the reluctance
7 of conveyancers to pass titles based upon tax titles;
8 therefore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law,
9 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10 convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 Any city or town which, acting under section six of
2 chapter three hundred and seventy-two of the acts of
3 nineteen hundred and forty-six or any act amendatory
4 thereof, has constructed a residence on land acquired by
5 such city or town through the foreclosure of a tax title
6 may, acting through the agent prescribed by section
7 eight of said chapter three hundred and seventy-two, as
8 amended, take such land by eminent domain for the
9 purpose of confirming its title thereto.
