

SENATE No. 736

To accompany the petition of John J. Beades that the city of Boston be authorized to convey to the Commonwealth for armory purposes certain land in the Dorchester district of said city. Cities.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF BOSTON TO CONVEY TO THE COMMONWEALTH FOR ARMORY PURPOSES CERTAIN LAND IN THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF SAID CITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any contrary provision of
2 general or special law, the city of Boston, acting by its
3 mayor, may without consideration convey to the com-
4 monwealth for armory purposes any part or parts or the
5 whole of the land on the northerly side of Victory road
6 in the Dorchester district of said city belonging to said
7 city and now under the care and custody of its parks
8 and recreation commission; provided, that such con-
9 veyance is authorized, after two separate readings, by
10 two separate votes of two thirds of all the members of
11 the city council of said city, the first of said readings and
12 votes to be had only after the conveyance is recom-
13 mended by said parks and recreation commission; and
14 the second of said readings and votes to be had not less
15 than fourteen days after the first.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
