**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SALE OF LAND NOW USED FOR CEMETERY PURPOSES BY THE TOWN OF MARSHFIELD TO THE FIRST CONGREGATIONAL CHURCH OF MARSHFIELD, INC.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The town of Marshfield is hereby au-  
2 thorized to sell and convey to the First Congregational  
3 Church of Marshfield, Inc. the following parcel of land  
4 now used for cemetery purposes:— Starting at a point  
5 on land now or formerly of Gratto and running in a  
6 westerly direction a distance of 50'; thence turning and  
7 running in a northerly direction along land of First  
8 Congregational Church of Marshfield, Inc. a distance of  
9 60'; thence turning and running diagonally in a south-  
10 east direction across cemetery land to the point of begin-  
11 ning. Containing 1,500 square feet more or less.

1 SECTION 2. The said town is further authorized to  
2 disinter and rebury such bodies which may be buried in  
3 said premises described in section one.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its accept-  
2 ance by the board of selectmen of the town of Marshfield.
